Virtual Meeting Protocol

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, only remote participation in public meetings will be permitted until further notice in order to keep residents safe and help stop the community spread of the virus.

All future public hearings will be held through GoToMeeting, a phone conferencing platform, to provide opportunity for live and transparent participation by the public. Public meetings that do not include public hearing items may be held through another platform. The platform used will be clearly stated on the public notice.

The following list is to help you better understand how to listen and participate in virtual public meetings:

- GoToMeetings can be accessed by phone, computer, and tablet. Anyone can join with these devices.
- All participants will be automatically muted upon entry into the meeting and will be unmuted by the meeting organizer during public comment agenda items. Please keep your microphone muted if you are not the one speaking.
- Do not log in from two devices with a microphone at once (for example, phone and computer) or you will create a reverb.
- Do not log in when in close proximity to someone else logged in or you will create a reverb.
- The chat feature will be disabled. We plan to conduct these virtual meetings as we would a regular meeting.

Public Comment Period

1. The meeting Chair will open public comment for the applicable agenda items. The meeting organizer will unmute all participants. If you do not want to make a comment, please mute yourself.
2. If you would like to make a public comment please state your name for the record and state your comments. All comments will be kept to a maximum of three minutes.
3. Once all comments have been heard, the meeting Chair will close the public comment period and the meeting organizer will mute all participants.
4. Comments may also be submitted prior to the public meeting. If the comments are for a Planning & Zoning meeting, send to the City of Sun Valley Community Development Department, preferably emailed to cdcounter@sunvalleyidaho.gov or mailed to PO Box 416, Sun Valley, ID 83353. If your comments are for a City Council meeting, send to City Clerk Nancy Flannigan, nflannigan@sunvalleyidaho.gov. Written comments received prior to the meeting shall be recognized during the meeting and included in the public record.
