## CITY OF SUN VALLEY RESOLUTION 2022-09

### RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUN VALLEY, IDAHO, RESERVING THE FORGONE AMOUNT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023 FOR POTENTIAL USE IN SUBSEQUENT YEARS AS DESCRIBED IN IDAHO CODE §63-802, et al.

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §50-235 empowers the City Council of each city to levy taxes for general revenue purposes;

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §50-1002 requires the city council of each city in the State of Idaho to pass a budget, referred to as an annual appropriation ordinance;

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §63-802 sets limitations on all taxing district budget requests on the amount of property tax revenues that can be used to fund programs and services;

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §63-802(1)(a) allows each taxing entity to increase property tax budget amounts by a maximum of 3%, plus an amount calculated based on the value of both new construction and annexation added during the previous calendar year, plus an amount for forgone taxes;

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §63-802(1)(f) requires that the City adopt an annual resolution to reserve additional forgone amount in order to utilize that amount in subsequent years;

WHEREAS, the City has met the notice and hearing requirements in Idaho Code §63-802(1)(f) to reserve the current year's increase in the forgone amount;

WHEREAS, the City has an accrued foregone reserve of \$970,942 and

WHEREAS, the City intends to reserve \$82,888 of its current year's increase in allowable forgone amount.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUN VALLEY, IDAHO, that \$82,888 of the current year's allowable increase in its forgone amount is reserved and included in the City's total forgone balance for potential use in subsequent years.

**ORDINANCE NO. 570  
ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF SUN VALLEY, IDAHO FOR  
THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2022**

**AN ORDINANCE TITLED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF SUN VALLEY, IDAHO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2022, APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF ELEVEN MILLION, FOUR HUNDRED NINETEEN THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$11,419,253) TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF SUN VALLEY FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR, AUTHORIZING A LEVY OF A SUFFICIENT TAX UPON THE TAXABLE PROPERTY, AND SPECIFYING THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSES FOR WHICH SAID APPROPRIATION IS MADE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sun Valley is a unit of local government organized and existing pursuant to Title 50 of the Idaho Code; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Idaho Code Section 50-1001, the City of Sun Valley fiscal year begins on the first day of October; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Idaho Code Section 50-1003, the City Council shall adopt an annual appropriation ordinance prior to the commencement of each fiscal year, which in no event shall be greater than the amount of the tentative budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the annual appropriation ordinance is prepared in accordance with Idaho Code Title 50 Chapter 10 governing finances; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sun Valley City Council considered said budget and has conducted a public hearing thereon and determined that said budget should be adopted.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUN VALLEY, IDAHO, COUNTY OF BLAINE, STATE OF IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1:** That the sum of Eleven Million, Four Hundred Nineteen Thousand, Two Hundred and Fifty-three dollars (\$11,419,253) be, and the same is appropriated to defray the necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Sun Valley, Blaine County, Idaho, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022.

**SECTION 2:** The objects and purposes for which such appropriation is made, and the amount of each object and purpose is as follows:

General Fund	7,153,031
Fixed Asset Fund	941,795
Debt Service Fund	1,387,296
Capital Improvement Fund	790,000
Workforce Housing Fund	180,531
1% Local Option Tax Fund	716,600
Street & Path Fund	250,000
2018 Bond Construction Fund	<u>0</u>
<b>Grand Total – All Funds</b>	<b><u><u>11,419,253</u></u></b>

**SECTION 3:** That a general tax levy on all taxable property within the City of Sun Valley be levied in an amount allowed by law for the general purposes for said City, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022.

**SECTION 4:** All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5:** This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon its passage, approval and publication according to law.
